Reading the Schedule

1. Decide whether you are going north (schedule at top) or south (schedule at bottom)
2. On the left-hand side, find the station from which you are leaving
3. Read across to find the times the Rail Runner departs from that station
4. From there, read down to find what time the train will arrive at the station to which you are going

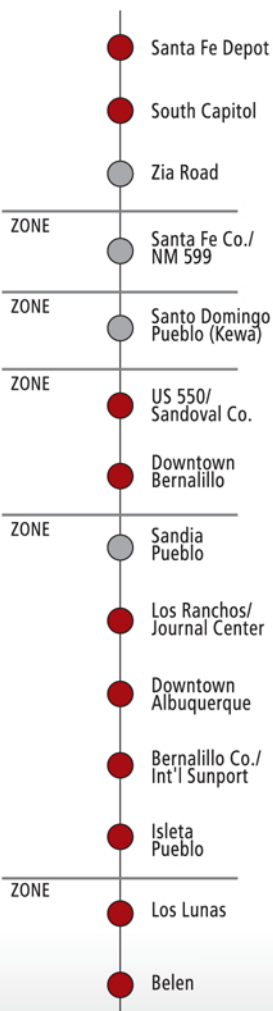

Calculating Your Fare

1. Count the number of zones

Count the number of zones through which you will travel. For example: traveling from Downtown Albuquerque to the Santa Fe Depot is 5 zones; traveling from Belen to Downtown Albuquerque is 2 zones.

2. Check the chart above and see how much your fare is
